<p style="writing-mode: vertical-rl; transform: rotate(180deg);"><b>In the Spotlight:</b> Featuring Resident and New Authors</p>	<p><b>Why a New Manuscript Category?</b></p>	<p><b><i>In the Spotlight!</i></b> is a new manuscript category of the CJNS designed to allow new authors including residents, fellows and faculty to present hypothesis-generating ideas, plans for a study, or a venue for showing preliminary results and inviting comments for their works-in-progress.</p> <p>The CJNS created this new manuscript category to assist researchers by providing a vehicle to communicate with peers on the progress of their work from the hypotheses to the knowledge translation stage prior to the creation of a formal review or original article.</p> <p>To assist new authors to become comfortable with the manuscript specifications required by the CJNS, the two Manuscript Categories applicable for submission to <b><i>In the Spotlight!</i></b> will be Review Articles and Original Articles.</p> <p><b><i>In the Spotlight!</i></b> will profile articles online for local, national and international colleagues to download at no cost.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b><i>Manuscripts submitted for this category will be eligible for publication starting January 1, 2013.</i></b></p>

		<p><b>Review Goal:</b></p> <p>The goal of the CJNS is to work collaboratively with authors to publish Manuscripts in a timely manner. Manuscripts are to be published within 6-8 months of receiving final revisions from the author.</p>
		<p><b>Posting to CJNS Online</b></p> <p>The goal of the CJNS is to post CJNS online for the 1<sup>st</sup> of the month, in January, March, May, July, September and November. Should your article not be posted on CJNS online after the 1<sup>st</sup>, please contact <a href="mailto:support@metapress.com">support@metapress.com</a>.</p>
		<p><b>Posting to PubMed</b></p> <p>Once a CJNS Issue and/or Supplement is posted within the CJNS online Journal, notification is provided to PubMed through Metapress. This notification may take up to one week from a Journal Issue or Supplement being uploaded to the CJNS online Journal. Upon receipt of notification, PubMed may take up to 72 hours to post Journal issues online. The goal is to have articles posted by the 15<sup>th</sup> of the month, in January, March, May, July, September and November.</p> <p>As PubMed is an organization outside of the CJNS, we do not have influence on how and when they post articles within their database.
