2012 Canadian Examinations Electroencephalography (EEG)

To assure and maintain a high standard of competence in clinical electroencephalography and electromyography across Canada, the Canadian Society of Clinical Neurophysiologists (CSCN) conducts an annual examination in EEG and EMG and related subjects for those eligible physicians entering EEG or EMG practice who elect to take it. Successful candidates will be given a certificate by the CSCN and will automatically be eligible for Active membership in the Society. The Provincial Licensing Bodies and the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada have been informed of this examination and of the objective of the CSCN to maintain high standards in the practice of Clinical Neurophysiology in Canada.

ELIGIBILITY: 1. Shall be a physician certified as specialist: a) in neurology (adult or paediatrics)
b) other specialists (with a minimum of 6 months of training in neurology), acceptable to the examination board.

2. Complete a minimum of 6 months of full-time formal EEG training within a two-year period. For example, training fragmented into multiple 1-2 month rotations spread over 3-4 years is NOT acceptable.

Note: i. Training shall be completed in electroencephalographic laboratories that perform a minimum of 1,500 electroencephalograms annually for a wide variety of adult and pediatric patients.
ii. Provide written evidence, from the laboratory medical director, of satisfactory completion of training by the candidate.
iii. Although a candidate may attempt the EEG examination during their specialty training, certification in EEG will NOT be granted until the examination board receives evidence of successful completion of both the specialty AND EEG examinations.

FORMAT: Oral and written examination.

LANGUAGE: The written and oral exams will be offered in English and French
