The 2012 President's Prize

The President's Prize is awarded annually for the best paper in pediatric neuroscience by a resident or fellow.

1. The prize consists of a certificate as well as:
 - o \$1,000 cash
 - o Full registration to the Congress, value \$600 (approx).
 - o Travel to the Congress, maximum \$700, receipts required.
 - o 2 nights accommodation, maximum \$500, receipts required.
2. A second place award of \$500 may be awarded as well.
3. In order to be eligible for this prize, contestants must be a member of one of the four Societies of the CNSF (a Junior member or an Active member within two years of receiving their certificate).
4. Full papers, prepared in the standard format of the Canadian Journal of Neurological Sciences, with an abstract of 200 words or less, should be submitted electronically in a PDF file.
5. The paper should not have been published or accepted for publication at the time of submission (with the exception of papers submitted to ICNA).
6. All Society Prize submissions must be received by **January 15, 2012**. This deadline is firm.
7. Contestants must also submit an abstract to the CNSF Annual Congress, on the official online abstract submission form.
